1) Introduction

a) The Holy Spirit throughout the Bible is Eternal

Heb 9:14

Creation – "Let us make man..."

Gen 1:1

- → All things came into being through Him, and apart from Him nothing came into being Jhn 1:3
- → The Spirit of God moved over the waters

Gen 1:1-2

o Jesus was born into this world (Christmas time) by the Holy Spirit

Lk 1:35

The Bible says Jesus was baptised, prayed, the Holy Spirit remained on him

Luke 3:21, Jhn 1:32

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Luke 4:18

God anointed Jesus with Holy Spirit and Power

Acts 10:38

- Transfigured on the mount, Died on the cross, Raised the dead...
 - → "For God (the Father) so loved the world that He gave His son"

Jhn 3:16

→ Jesus said, "I'll go... I'll pay the price and lay my life down"

Jhn 10:17

→ The Holy Spirit said: "Hey, I'll be the power and I'll raise to back to life"

Jesus started His ministry, preaching: "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me & Anointed"

Rom 8:11

- His blood, forgiveness of sin lives on forever Because the *Holy Spirit is Eternal*
 - **rnal** Heb 9:14

- Holy Spirit at Salvation
 - After Jesus' death and resurrection, He appear to the disciples who were hiding in fear
 - Jesus said: "I, the Spirit of Christ, the Spirit of Truth, I will come to you"
 - He said: "I will not leave you as orphans, I will come to you and be in you". Jhn 14:18, 16-17
 - Then he breathed on the Disciples and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit" John 20:22
 The Disciples became the firm born-again Christians recorded in the Bible
 - He never leaves us or forsakes us, He is our coach; He is our guide & mentor & Teacher
- For us today
 - When we believe in Jesus, The Holy Spirit moves on the inside of believers
 Regeneration of the human spirit, transforming us, transferring us from death to life, from darkness to light all by the Power of the Holy Spirit
 - He Convicts of sin & Righteousness; He teaches us <u>ALL</u> things
 - The Holy Spirit now lives in the lives of believers everywhere developing in us Fruit Gal 5:22-2!
 Love, Joy, Peace, Patience, Kindness, Goodness, Faithfulness, Gentleness, Self-control
- o But there is more wait for Power of the Holy Spirit

Acts 1:4,8, Lk 24:9

→ Notice it said "Be", not necessarily to go witnessing, but your life will be a witness

There is additional Power Available

b) Rebuilding Solomon' Temple

"It's not by might, not by power, but by my Spirit say the Lord"

Zechariah 4:6

2) Oil of the Holy Spirit / Candle Stick

- Symbols used in the Bible to represent the Holy Spirit include:
 - o Water, Rain, Dew, Fire, Dove
 - o Wind, Oil

a) Holy Spirit supply is continuous

Zechariah 4:1-5, Ex 25:31-40

Just as the oil trees in the vision continually supplied oil to the lamps on the lampstand.
 God wants His supply and our reliance on the Holy Spirit to be continual.

b) The Church is represented as a candle stick.

o Isaiah tells us that we are to arise and shine for our light has come...

Isaiah 60:1

Jesus said: "You are the light of the world"

Matt 5:14-15

Oil lamps need a wick – symbolic of man's heart

Matt 25:7

We need our hearts saturated with the Holy Spirit oil (anointing)

Lk 4:18, Acts 10:38

The light is produced at the mouth of the lamp

What is coming out of our mouths

Rev 2:12, Heb 10:23

- 'Seven' represent: Completion & Perfection
- Gold is symbolic of Purity & being Precious.
 - We the church are to be holy, and we are precious to Jesus. He is working through us.
 - Gold never tarnishes The glory of Gold never fades and represents immense value.
- Oil is a good representation of the Holy Spirit
 - Oil *lubricates* less friction and wear & tear among those who are lubricated by the Spirit of God
 - Oil *heals*, medicinal treatment the Spirit of God brings healing and restoration

Lk 10:3

- Oil lights when it is burned in a lamp where the Spirit of God is there is light / revelation
- Oil warms when it is used as fuel for a flame Spirit of God brings warmth and comfort
- Oil invigorates when used to massage the Holy Spirit invigorates us for His service
- Oil adorns when applied as a perfume the Holy Spirit makes us more pleasant to be around
- Oil polishes when used to shine metal the Holy Spirit wipes away grime, smoothing rough edges
- Oil anoints Kings used to designate purpose and rulership
- You are the light of the world me!? Yes "not by might, not by power, but by My Spirit"

3) Abraham and Gifts

Gen 24:1-67

There is an amazing depiction of the Father, Jesus and the Holy Spirit in Old Testament

- → **Abraham** would be representative of **Father God**
- → *Isaac* would be representative of *Jesus*
- → The *servant* could be representative of the *Holy Spirit*

1 Cor 12: 1-4, 1 Cor 12: 7-11

5) Pneumatikos

• Now about the spiritual gifts brethren, I do not want you to be misinformed.

1 Cor 12: 1,4

- The noun "gifts" is not actually in the original Grek text in 1 Corinthians 12:1
- The original Greek text used an adjective here, 'pneumatikos'
 - → Human spirit
 - → Divine Spirit
 - → Filled and governed by the Holy Spirit
 - → Wind breath blowing
- We get the word Pneumatics from this Greek word meaning πνεῦμα pneuma wind, breath
- In the Bible 'pneumatikos', is always used in relation to the work of the Holy Spirit

1 Corinthians 12: 1 (ampc)

Now about the <u>spiritual qifts</u> (the special endowments of supernatural energy), I do not want you to be misinformed.

Ephesians 3:20

Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we **ask** or **think** or even **imagine**, according to the **Power that works in us.**
