

Transformed by a voice #4 – Reset

Voices Process: Hear → Speak → Act 2 Cor 4:13, Prov 18:21

- **Reset – Forget network**

1) This is not new – Tried it before

- **DISCOURAGED / DISAPOINTED**

a) I wanted the answer “My Way”

b) Faith corresponding (according) to your faith

Matt 9:29 Matt 7:7

- Appropriate actions are speaking His Voice until you get a revelation

2) Peter also got Discouraged & Disappointed

a) Discouragement

Matt 26:31 /John 18:10

- **Discouragement** leads to us following at a distance; *disengaged detached*
 - Peter followed at a distance **Matt 26:58**

b) Disappointment

- Peter denies Jesus x 3. Now Peter is **Disappointed** with himself
- **Disappointment** leads us to give up and quit; why bother trying again
- Peter leaves and says: “I’m going back to my fishing” **John 21:3**

3) Reset & Forget – Good news

- Jesus call out to them: “*Caught anything*”, *Cast out on the other side*”
- Peter put on his coat: I’m following Jesus
- We can be restored in relationship and follow Jesus again

4) Distractions

- We start something: hearing, speaking, and acting, but then get distracted

a) Don’t let Distraction choke the Word

- The cares of this world distract us **Mark 4:18**
- “*Set your mind on things above, not on the things of the earth*” **Col 3:1**

b) David got Distracted **2 Sam 11 & 12**

- “*It just happened*”. David immediately hear a new inner voice; his own voice “*He inquired about her...*” **2 Sam 11:3**
- Someone said, “*Is this not somebody else’s wife?*”, another voice – a check!!!
- But David allowed the voices to continue, he did not RESET & FORGET
- Following the wrong voices resulted in adultery and led to death of his son

Prov 4:20-24

5) Conclusion

- Don’t allow the 3 D’s to stop you hearing, speaking & acting on God’s voice
- Following the wrong voice leads to death
- Following God’s voice leads to Life
- Let us come now in a time of worship and RESET
 - Ask God to forgive you
 - Commit yourself again to follow the Shepherd
 - Like David – Lets worship the King
